All that remains is for me to wish you all a safe and peaceful half-term and we look forward to seeing you all back on Monday 28 February.

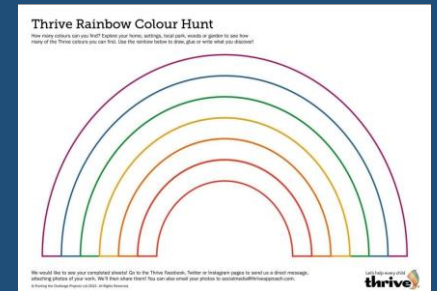
Safeguarding
