Follow the TALK checklist to help keep your child safe online (Internet Watch Foundation).

The IWF tells us that "Since the start of the pandemic, the amount of "self-generated" inappropriate child imagery has been increased dramatically. In 2020 the IWF confirmed 68,000 cases of such imagery, a rise of 77% on the year before. It accounts for nearly half (44%) of the imagery we took action on last year. In 80% of cases the victims were 11 to 13 year old girls". The IWF has created a resource to help parents and carers understand the risks of "self-generated inappropriate child imagery" using the acronym TALK.
