Please look out for our Talk Time pictures which we will stick in your child's contact book. This is for you to use with your child to help with speech and language development. Enjoy discussing the pictures and help your child to learn some new vocabulary. Some question starters are provided for you.

Being in Sheldrick class:

In Sheldrick class we play and learn in the indoor and outside environment every day! The children will often be involved in messy and sensory play activities and may sometimes come home a little messy (even though they will have worn an apron!) However, they will have been having fun and learning some important things in the process! Please provide appropriate clothing for the weather conditions, including warm and waterproof coats and shoes. **Don't forget to label all the children's clothes with their names.**

This term we are going to be working on zipping up and buttoning their own coats. It would be helpful if you can practice this at home with your child too.
