Thrive fun to try at home with your child/children

If possible, look to do these activities for as much as 20 minutes or more each day. Monday Use a finger to draw a flower on your child's hand; extend this to a guessing game with older children by drawing a shape, number, pattern or creature. Tuesday Dance together: perhaps teach your child a dance you did when you were younger. Be willing to learn one from them. Wednesday Make a den with cushions, blankets, bed sheets, clothes pegs, pillows – anything soft! Thursday Do loud singing then quiet singing, or very active movement then slow movement eg. find your favourite song and create a dance for it. Friday Use face paints together eg. favourite animals
